

Works Notification

Out of hours works and temporary parking removal Yarra Street, South Yarra

Saturday 7 August to Monday 9 August

As part of the works to connect the new Metro Tunnel to the existing corridor rail lines, we will be installing underground service cables within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations during the 24-hour rail works while trains are redirected.

What we are doing

- Installing underground signalling cable assets and conduits
- Works require the use of a cable truck and crews with hand tools.

When

Underground cable installation works

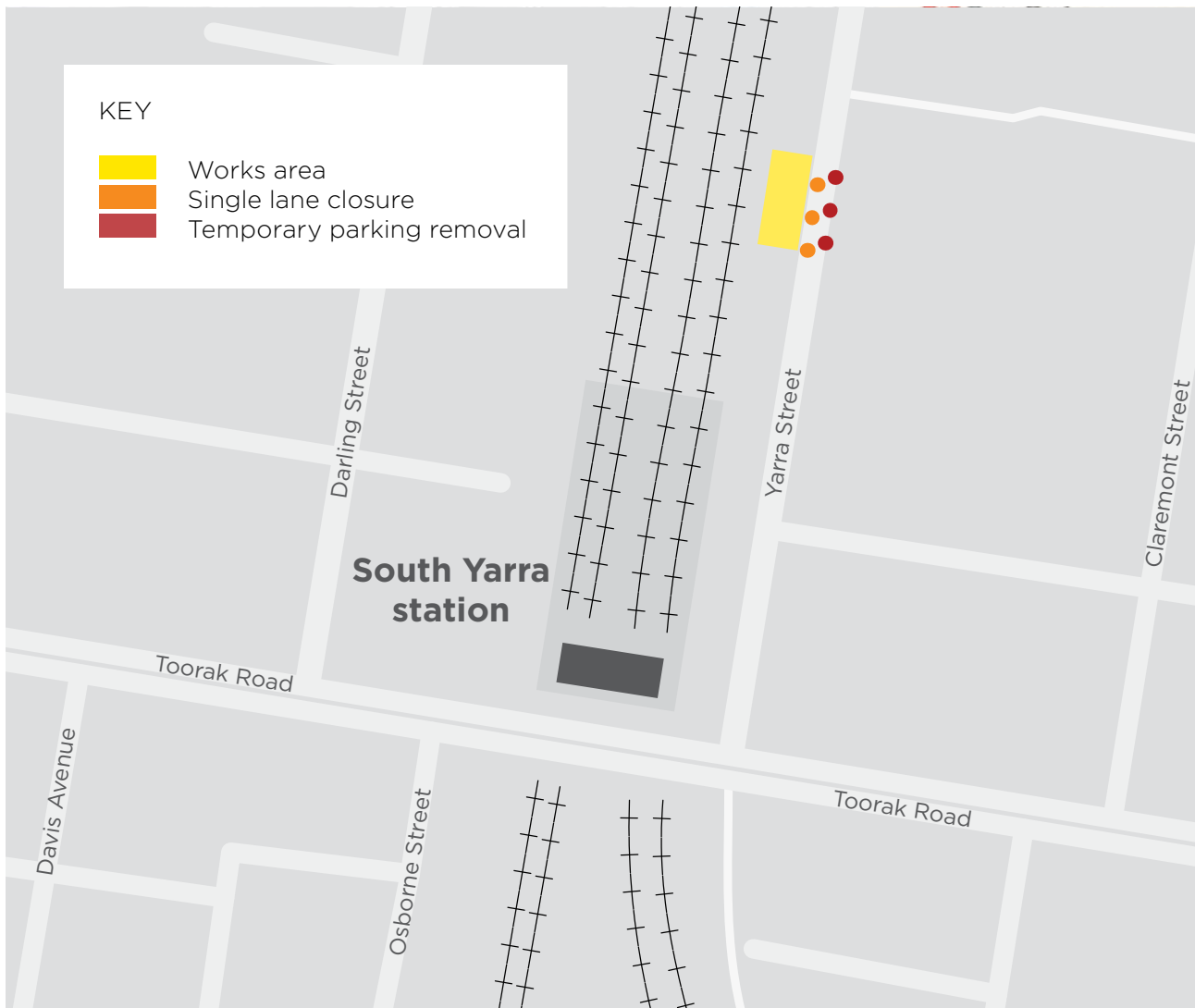
- 7am to 7pm, Sunday 8 August.

Temporary parking removal on Yarra Street

- 6pm Saturday 7 August to 7am Monday 9 August.

What you should be aware of

- Additional truck movements will be required along Yarra Street, as materials are being delivered to our works area
- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise
- A single lane closure is required to undertake this activity safely and some parking will be temporarily unavailable to maintain local traffic movements along Yarra Street
- Traffic management will be in place along Yarra Street to facilitate local vehicles from entering and exiting the road. Local residential access will be maintained during this time.
