

# Works Notification

## Out of hours works and temporary lane closure Arthur Street, South Yarra

**Thursday 26 August to Monday 30 August**

Further to the previously notified 24-hour works within the rail corridor between South Yarra and Caulfield stations, a single lane closure on Arthur Street is required to install an overhead structure while trains are not running.

### What we are doing

- A crane will be set up on Arthur Street to lift materials into the rail corridor
- Installing an overhead gantry structure within the rail corridor near Chapel Street
- Works will require the use of elevated work platforms, generators, a crane, an excavator and crews with hand tools.

### When

#### 24-hour rail works

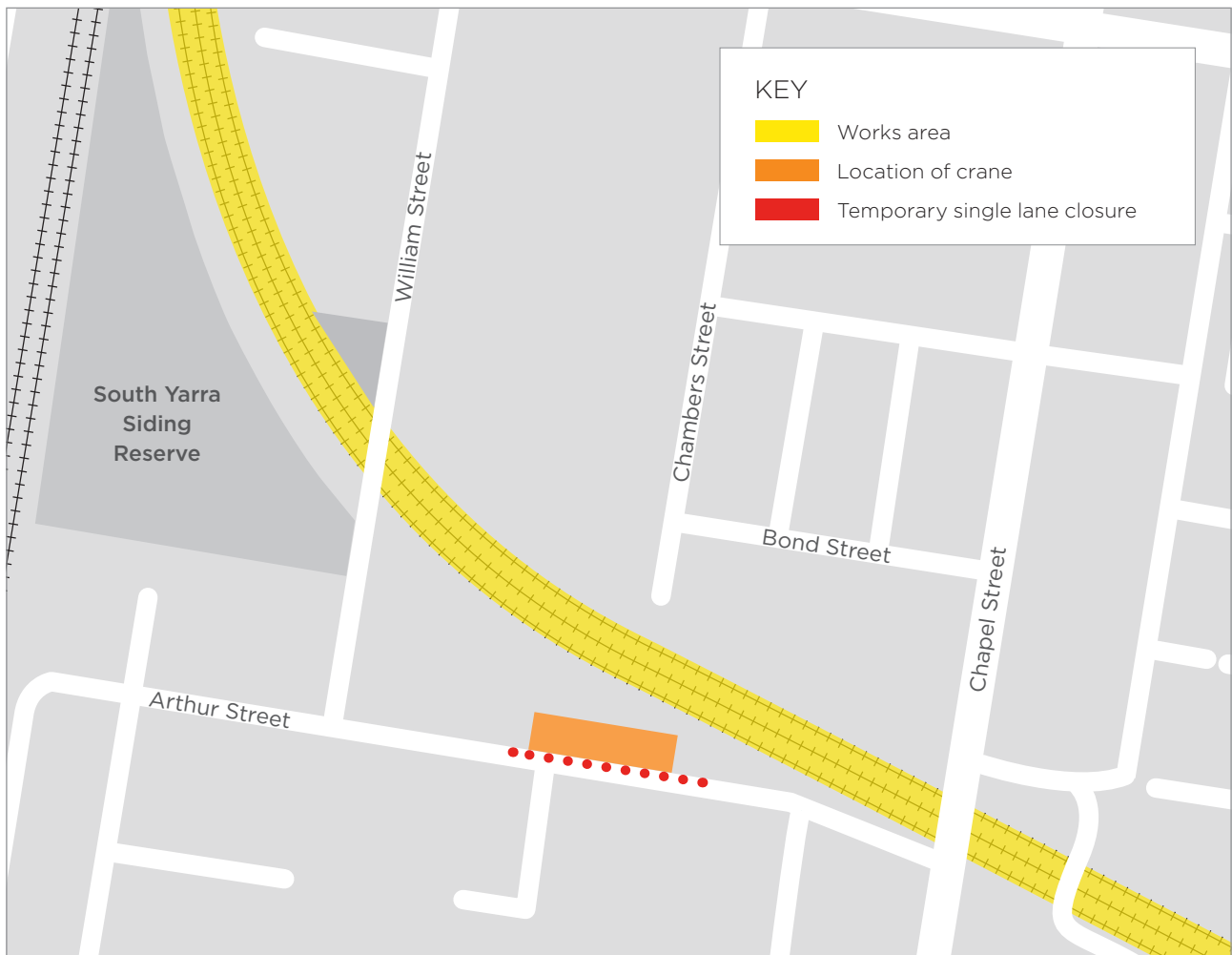
- 8pm Friday 27 August to 3am Monday 30 August.

#### Temporary lane closure on Arthur Street

- 6pm Thursday 26 August to 7am Sunday 29 August.

### What you should be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise
- Traffic management will be in place to facilitate local vehicles entering and exiting the road. Local residential access will be maintained during this time
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.
