



Works Notification

24-hour rail works

Railway Crescent, Cremorne

October 2021

As part of works to ready the existing rail lines for the Metro Tunnel, we will be undertaking 24-hour rail works within the rail corridor between White Street and South Yarra station. Temporary parking closures on Railway Crescent will be required to support works within the corridor.

What we are doing

- Installing underground rail assets and conduits within the rail corridor
- Works will require the use of an excavator, a non-destructive digging (NDD) truck and crews with hand tools
- NDD uses pressurised water to dig and then vacuum up the soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them.

When

24-hour rail works

- 8pm Friday 22 October to 3am Monday 25 October
- 8pm Friday 29 October to 9pm Sunday 31 October.

Temporary parking removal on Railway Crescent

- 6pm Friday 22 October to 7am Monday 25 October
- 6pm Friday 29 October to 9pm Sunday 31 October.

What you should be aware of

- Additional truck movements will be required along Railway Crescent and Green Street, as materials are being delivered to our rail access point
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise
- Temporary on-street parking removal from Railway Crescent will be in place to ensure safe and efficient material deliveries and construction vehicle access to the rail corridor
- Traffic management will be in place along Railway Crescent, Green and White streets to safely facilitate local vehicles from entering and exiting the road. Local residential access will be maintained during this time
- Generator-powered lighting towers will be required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators.



Health and safety

Works safely resumed from 5 October on the Metro Tunnel with COVID-Safe Plans in place to help protect workers and the community.

Strict processes are in place to check and record the vaccination status of workers entering construction sites.
