



TRAM NETWORK IMPROVEMENT

TRAM STOP FINISHING WORKS

PARK STREET, SOUTH MELBOURNE

FRIDAY, 30 NOVEMBER - WEDNESDAY, 19 DECEMBER

Works are continuing on Park Street, South Melbourne to complete the installation of the new Wells Street tram stop (Stop 119).

Linemarking and cracksealing

12.30am to 5.30am

Friday, 30 November to Saturday, 1 December

These works include:

- Linemarking on the platform stop
- Applying crack sealant to repair parts of the road.

These works are expected to generate low levels of noise.

Access will be maintained for residents and businesses at all times via traffic management.

Installation of new Zebra Crossings

9.30pm to 5.30am

Tuesday, 4 December to Friday, 7 December

These works include:

- Installation of new zebra crossings at the intersection of Park Street, Wells Street and Palmerston Crescent
- Installation of curbing.

These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise.

Access will be maintained for residents and businesses at all times via traffic management.

Road resurfacing

9.30pm to 5.30am

Wednesday, 5 December to Thursday, 6 December

These works include:

- Resurfacing of the road on Park Street between Little Bank and Wells Streets.

These works are expected to generate high levels of noise.

Park Street will be closed to traffic during this time. (See map overleaf for detour.)

Rectification works

8pm to 5am

Monday, 10 December to Friday, 14 December

These works include:

- Rectification works along Park St where required.

These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise.

Access will be maintained for residents and businesses at all times via traffic management.

Removal of redundant poles

12.30am to 5.30am

Tuesday, 17 December to Thursday, 20 December

These works include:

- Removal of nine redundant poles.





This activity is expected to generate low to medium levels of noise.

9.30pm Wednesday, 5 December to 5.30am Thursday, 6 December
