



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### DRAINAGE WORKS AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS - PALFREYMAN STREET **TUESDAY 3 TO TUESDAY 10 DECEMBER 2019**

As part of the Metro Tunnel works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra, upgrades to drainage near the rail corridor are required. Drainage works will take place in the northern end of Palfreyman Street. In order to facilitate these works, Palfreyman Street between Garden Street and the rail corridor will be temporarily closed.

#### What we are doing

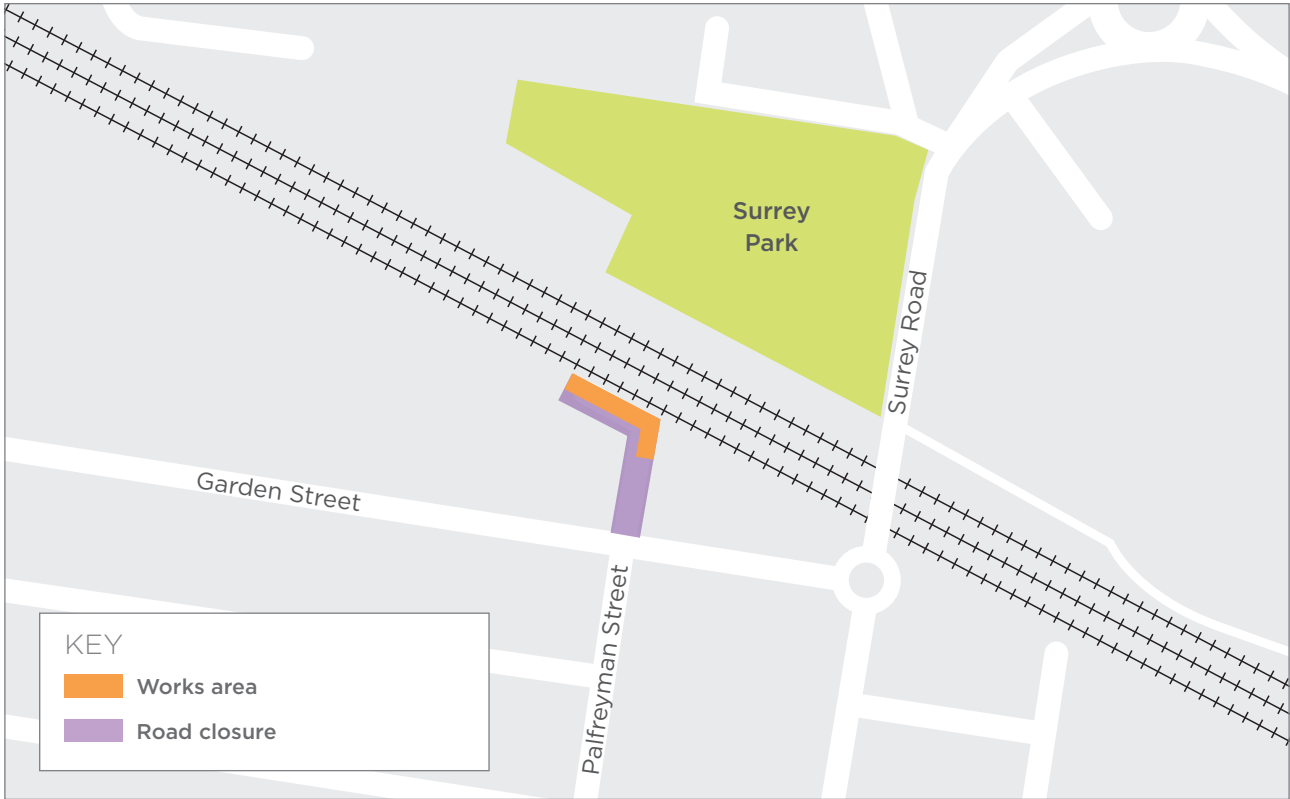
- Excavation, drilling and digging for the new drainage
- Tying the recently installed drainage along the rail corridor into the existing drainage under Palfreyman Street
- These works will involve a small work crew with an excavator, drill and hand tools.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium-levels of noise with periods of high-level noise as we excavate
- Palfreyman Street, between Garden Street and the rail corridor, will be temporarily closed to all traffic from 7am Tuesday 3 December to 6pm Tuesday 10 December.

- Tuesday 3 to Tuesday 10 December
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturday.
