Tree removal

Franklin Street West laydown area

Tuesday 30 March 2021

Major construction is continuing in the State Library Station Precinct. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area.

A tree located within the Franklin Street West laydown area has been identified for removal. Works will be undertaken to remove the tree from within the Franklin Street West laydown area and within a small works area on Franklin Street.

What we are doing

- Removing a tree within the Franklin Street West laydown area (refer to map)
- These works will require the use of an elevated works platform, a chainsaw, a truck and a woodchipper.

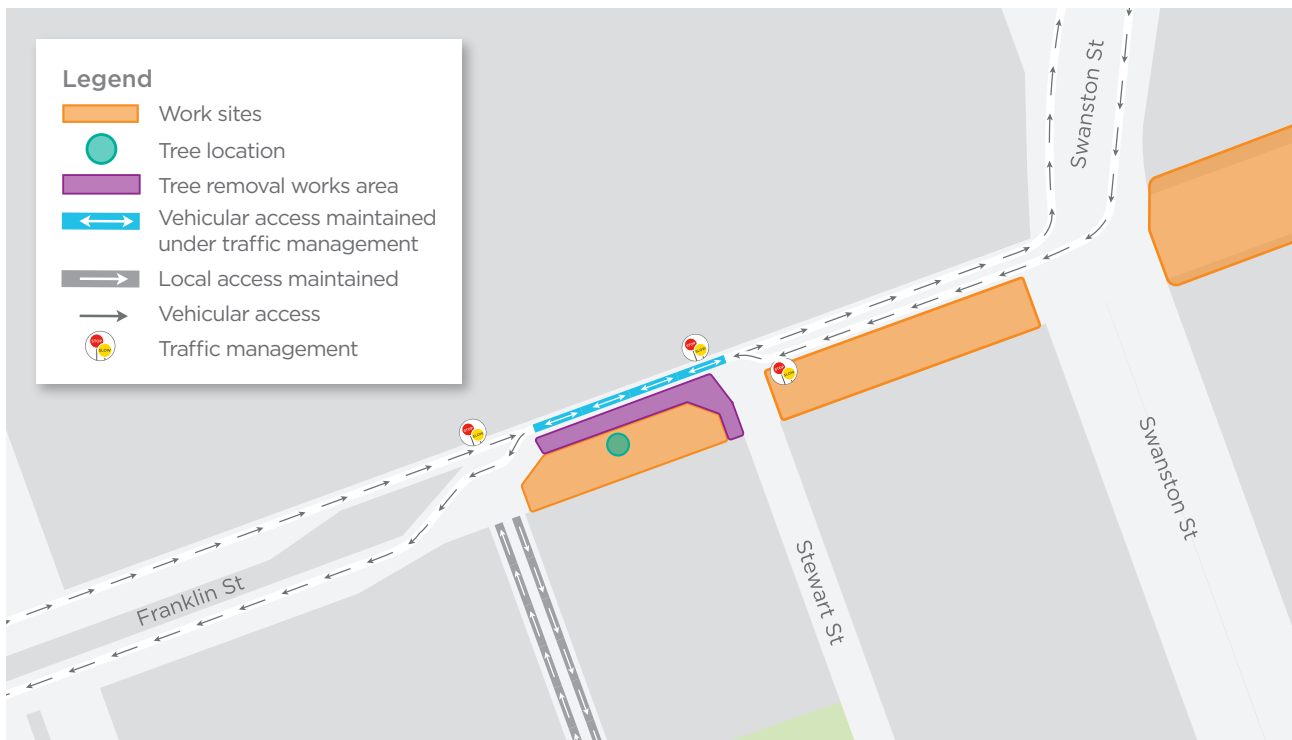
What you should be aware of

- During these works, traffic management will be in place on Franklin Street (refer to map)

- There will be intermittent holding of motorists travelling adjacent to the works area (refer to map)
- Motorists should allow extra time when travelling through this area
- Local access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- There will be no impacts to pedestrians during these works
- Removal of the tree will enable the installation of additional site sheds and a concrete pump to be built and accessed safely.
