

Works Notification

Temporary overnight road closure of Chambers and Bond streets

Chambers and Bond streets, South Yarra

Tuesday 18 to Friday 21 May 2021

As previously notified in the May construction update, deliveries of the Communications Equipment Room and Signalling Equipment Room (CER/SER) will take place over three nights.

What we are doing

- The new CER/SER buildings are being constructed off site and will be delivered via six oversize deliveries between Wednesday 19 and Friday 21 May
- To minimise disruption to local traffic, tram and bus services, oversized deliveries will take place along major arterial roads at night under VicRoads supervision
- Overnight deliveries are required to occur between 1am and 5am
- Trucks will travel west bound along Toorak Road, reverse into Chambers Street and then reverse into site where the buildings will be unloaded by crane and lowered into place. The trucks will then exit via Bond Street and onto Chapel Street.

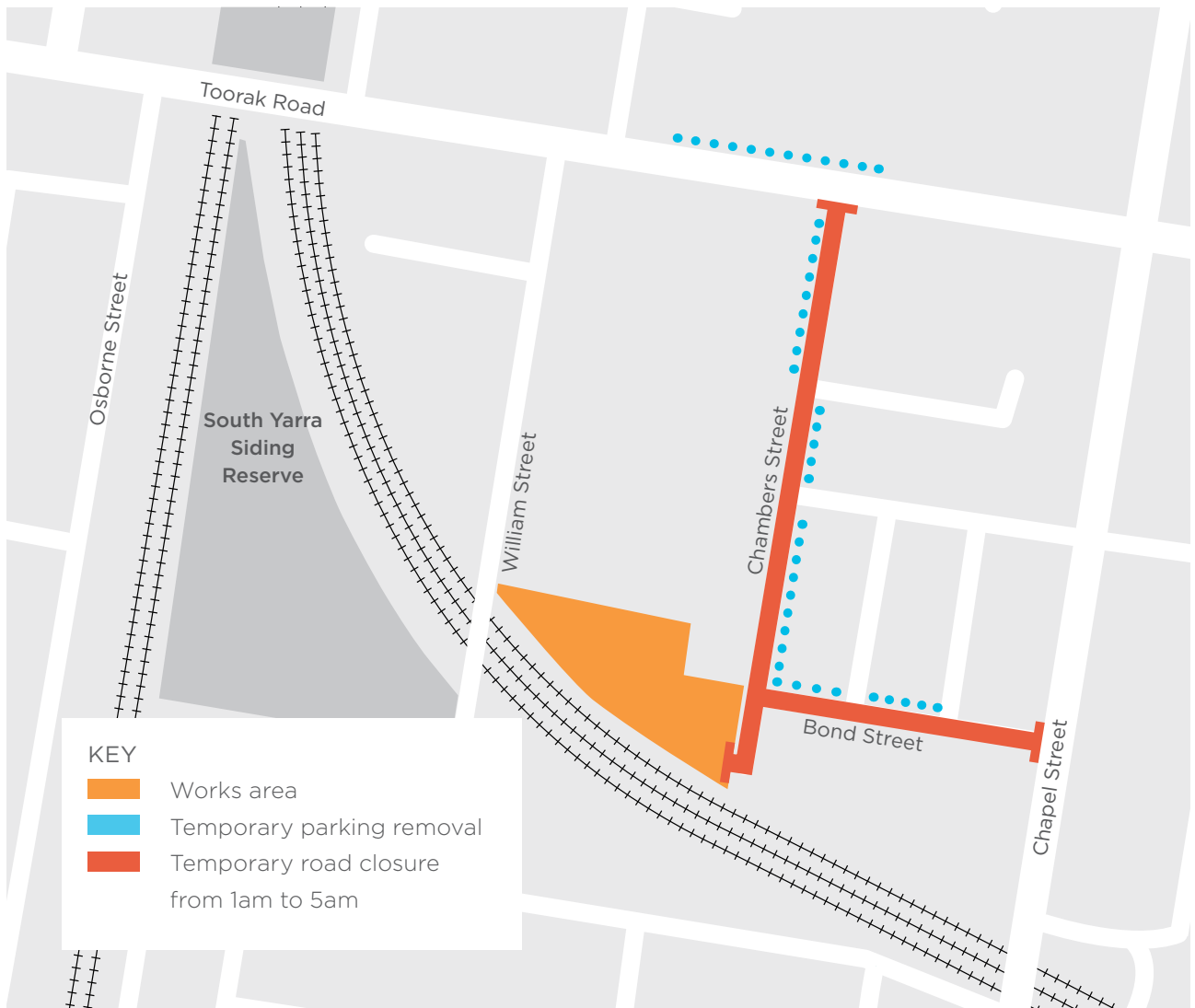
- Tuesday 18 to Friday 21 May.

Overnight deliveries

- Wednesday 19 to Friday 21 May
- Between 1am and 5am.

What you should be aware of

- Traffic management will be in place along Toorak Road, Chambers, Bond and Chapel streets while the buildings are delivered to site
- Chambers and Bond streets will be temporarily closed as the buildings are manoeuvred into site
- To ensure works are undertaken safely and efficiently, parking along Chambers and Bond streets will be temporarily unavailable from Tuesday 18 to Friday 21 May
- Works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some high-level peaks when the crane is lifting the buildings into place
- These works will be completed under directional lighting to ensure the safety of our workers. Every effort will be made to direct these lights away from residential properties.
