



## WORKS NOTIFICATION

### RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES NORMANBY ROAD AND CAULFIELD STATION

**FRIDAY 3 TO FRIDAY 24 APRIL 2020**

As part of the Metro Tunnel works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra, we will be continuing rail infrastructure upgrades and service investigations in Caulfield.

#### What we are doing

- Trenching and excavation works to install new signalling infrastructure for future trains using the Metro Tunnel
- These works will require the use of excavators, concrete pumps and hand tools
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to locate and expose underground services and cables at Caulfield station
- NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil to expose assets and services underground without damaging them.

#### When

- Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm
- Saturday, 7am to 1pm.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with some periods of high level noise
- Some parking will also be removed along Normanby Road to safely facilitate traffic changes
- Access will be maintained in both directions along Normany Road.

#### Health and safety

The health and safety of our workers is our key priority as we continue to deliver the Metro Tunnel Project, as is supporting social distancing measures in line with current health advice. We have strict protocols in place to protect the safety of our construction workforce, including enhanced industrial cleaning arrangements, provision of personal protective equipment and measures to reduce staff contact, including staggered shifts.
