



WORKS NOTIFICATION

TEMPORARY ROAD REALIGNMENT - LLOYD STREET, KENSINGTON **29 AUGUST TO 14 SEPTEMBER 2018**

Major construction on the Metro Tunnel has commenced in Kensington. The next phase of work includes the temporary realignment of Lloyd Street to prepare for the construction of the tunnel cross passages.

Cross passages are short tunnels that connect parallel tunnels. On the Metro Tunnel, they will be located at regular distances to allow access from one tunnel to another in the event of an emergency. The cross passages are a key component of the project's underground rail evacuation and emergency management system.

We are building three cross passages in Kensington. The first of these is beneath Lloyd Street (between Bakehouse Road and Radcliffe Street), outside the eastern entrance to the Lloyd Street Business Estate. Another two cross passages will be constructed beneath Bakehouse Road and McLennan Drive within the Lloyd Street Business Estate. Due to the ground conditions in these areas, ground improvement works are required before tunnelling and cross passage construction.

Before the cross passages can be built, we need to strengthen the ground to ensure the structural integrity of the cross passages. This is achieved by injecting grout into the ground from the surface above the site.

We need to realign a section of Lloyd Street before we can commence ground improvement works to ensure we are able to maintain traffic flow in both directions during the works.

What we are doing

- Realigning a section of Lloyd Street, between Bakehouse Road and Radcliffe Street, as shown on the map overleaf
- Establishing a work site, including site offices and worker amenities
- Delivering equipment and materials to site
- Non-destructive digging using a vacuum truck to determine the location of underground services
- Saw cutting sections of the road and kerb
- Removing the traffic island on Lloyd Street using excavators and trucks
- Temporarily relocating the traffic lights
- Using excavators and a vibrating roller to create the new road alignment
- Installing signage and new line marking
- Reinstalling and reprogramming the traffic lights to support traffic flow in the area
- Installing barriers, fencing and gates along the boundary of the current northbound lane to delineate the ground improvement work area.

What to expect

- Lloyd Street will be closed to all traffic between Radcliffe and Arden streets from **8pm - 5am, Wednesday 29 August to Friday 14 September 2018**
- All works will take place at night to minimise impacts on traffic and local businesses
- Any vehicles requiring access to the Lloyd Street Business Estate between the hours of 8pm and 5am will need to use the western entrance at Childers Street. Signage will be in place to notify vehicles of these arrangements
- Between 5am and 8pm, and on weekends, we will maintain one lane of traffic in either direction on Lloyd Street. During these times, access to the Lloyd Street Business Estate's eastern entrance off Lloyd Street will be maintained
- The speed limit on Lloyd Street will be temporarily reduced to 40km/h throughout the works. Please obey signage and traffic controllers in the area
- There will be no designated cycle path on Lloyd Street during these works. Cyclists are advised to use Dynon Road and obey signage in the area

- The works are expected to generate periods of medium to high level noise and some vibration
- Water carts will be used to prevent the spread of dust
- The current road alignment and cycle lane will be reinstated once the ground improvement works are complete (anticipated in December 2018). Additional notification will be provided in advance of this occurring.

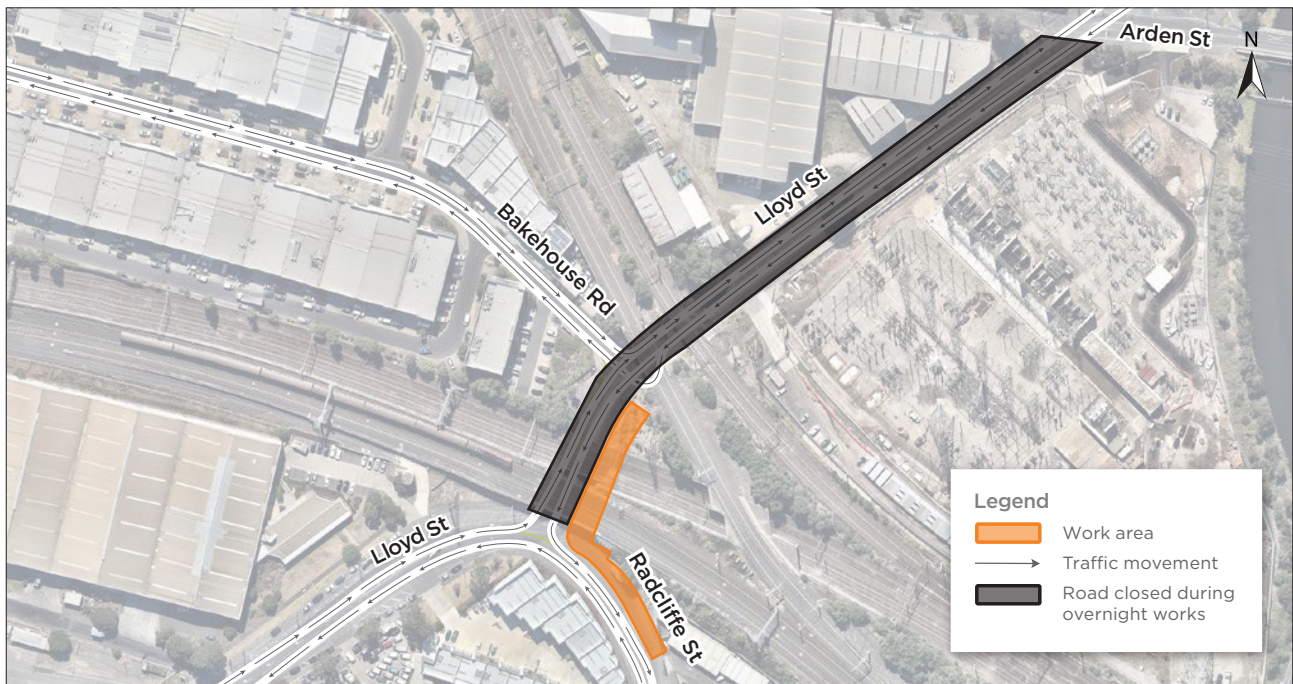
When

- 8pm to 5am, Wednesday 29 August to Friday 14 September 2018**
- No works on Friday or Saturday nights or during normal daytime construction hours.

Ground improvement works

Following the completion of road realignment works, ground improvement works on Lloyd Street will commence in mid-September and will take approximately four months to complete.
