



WORKS NOTIFICATION

OUT OF HOURS WORKS WEST FOOTSCRAY FEBRUARY 2019

Works are required in the rail corridor at West Footscray station to identify the location of underground services and prepare the area to build a new platform and track. The new infrastructure will be built as part of the Metro Tunnel Project.

What we are doing

Site establishment

- Installing temporary fencing to separate workers from operating trains.

Rail corridor site preparation and service investigations

- Working on the existing overhead wiring network with hand tools
- Installing signal gantry foundations
- Upgrading existing rail sleepers
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate ground conditions and to confirm the area is free of underground services.

When

Site establishment

- 7pm Saturday 2 February to 7am Sunday 3 February
- 7pm Saturday 9 February to 7am Sunday 10 February.

Rail corridor site preparation and service investigations

- 9pm Saturday 23 February to 4am Monday 25 February.

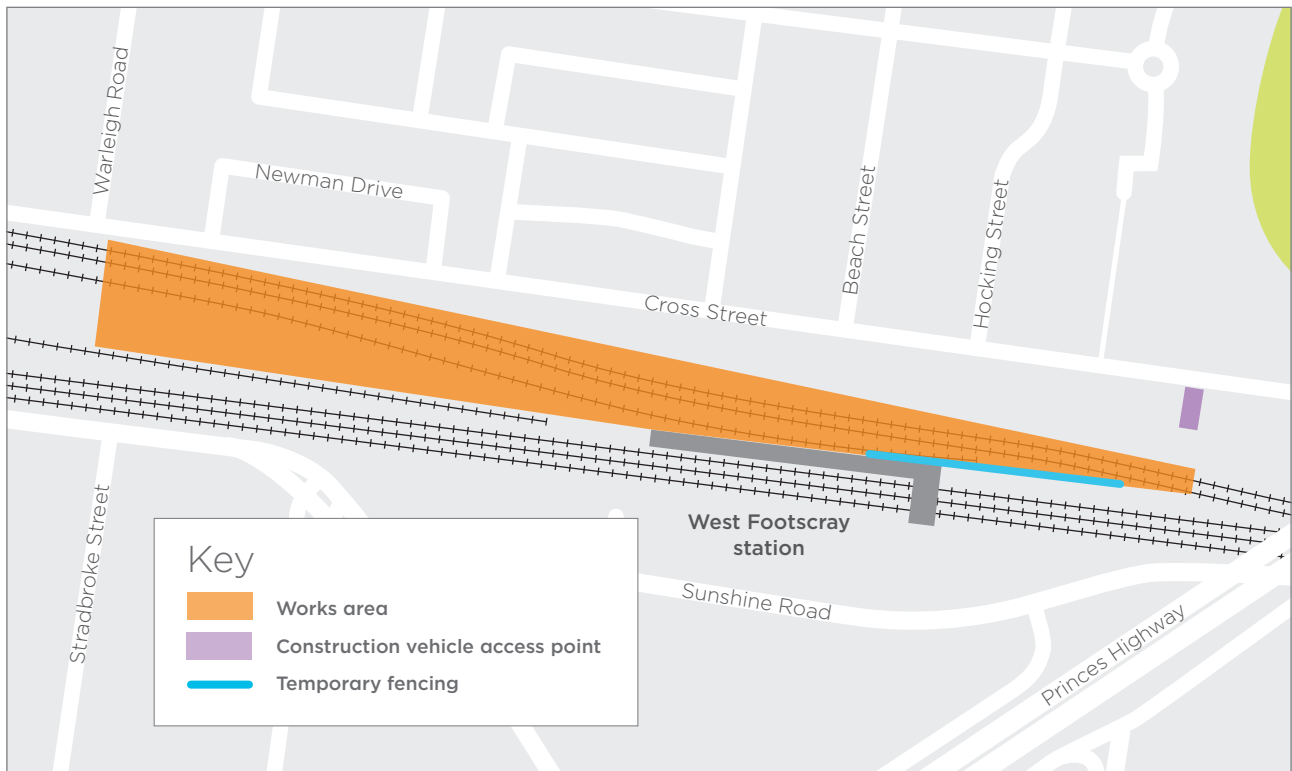
What to be aware of

- To ensure the safety of passengers and our workers, these activities can only be performed safely when trains are not operating
- The works are expected to generate periods of medium to high level noise during NDD activities. All other activities are expected to generate low levels of noise
- The works are expected to generate low levels of vibration
- Use of light towers will be required. We will position lights so they face away from residential properties, where possible
- Construction vehicles will be accessing the rail corridor via Cross Street (opposite Whitten Oval) see map overleaf
- To minimise disruption to the local community and rail users, important Metro Trains Melbourne maintenance works will also be carried out at this time. For more information on these works visit: metrotrains.com.au.

Travel Changes



Buses will replace trains at various times in February to enable works to take place safely in the rail corridor. These disruptions will take place outside of weekday peak times.
