EASTERN PORTAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Construction of the eastern tunnel entrance in South Yarra will enable Cranbourne and Pakenham line trains to travel via the new Metro Tunnel and connect with the Sunbury line.

Metro Tunnel works are currently underway in South Yarra, with the Cross Yarra Partnership (CYP) undertaking works to construct the tunnel boring machine retrieval shaft and the Rail Infrastructure Alliance (RIA) undertaking early works to prepare the area for construction of the eastern tunnel entrance.

RIA has prepared a draft RIA Eastern Portal Development Plan, which sets out required surface works to construct the eastern tunnel entrance and describes the response to the Urban Design Strategy and relevant Environmental Performance Requirements, as defined in the Metro Tunnel Environmental Management Framework.

Proposed works

Construction at South Yarra includes construction of a cut-and-cover tunnel, decline structure and track work to tie in the new tunnel with the existing rail line. Other works include reinstatement and enhancement of the South Yarra Siding Reserve, roads and walkways, and the construction of a replacement bridge at William Street, new pedestrian bridge at Osborne Street, retaining walls and embankments, and a new promenade connecting the South Yarra Siding Reserve to Chapel Street.

The draft RIA Eastern Portal Development Plan is available for public inspection and comment on the Metro Tunnel website at metro.tunnel.vic.gov.au from **Monday 4 February 2019** until **5pm, Friday 22 February 2019**. The website includes a link to the draft Development Plan and an online survey for you to provide a submission if you wish to. Anyone may make a submission on the plan.

Feedback received during public display will be considered in the finalisation of the RIA Eastern Portal Development Plan. An updated plan will then be submitted to the Minister for Planning for consideration.

The Minister for Planning must approve the draft RIA Development Plan before works covered in the Plan may commence.
