

Works Notification

Drainage works and use of a generator Kensington

Monday 26 April to late-May 2021

Works at 1-39 Hobsons Road are progressing to complete the Signalling and Communications Equipment Rooms (SER/CER). As part of these works, a small section of drainage pipes will be installed within the site. A temporary generator will be required to operate 24/7 to redirect water while these works are undertaken.

What we are doing

- Installing a new section of drainage at 1-39 Hobsons Road
- A generator and pump is required to temporarily divert water.

When

- Monday 26 April to late-May 2021 (works will take place during normal construction hours only)
- A generator operating 24/7 for up to two weeks will power a pump to temporarily divert water while works take place.


What you should be aware of

- The generator and pump will be located on the corner of Hobsons Road and Kensington Road within the 1-39 Hobsons Road site
- Due to the nature of these works, the generator cannot be located in a different location
- The generator will be surrounded by acoustic blankets to reduce noise
- Some low levels of noise may be noticeable to nearby residents.
