

Works Notification

Shared User Path Closure and Out of Hours Works between Caulfield Station and Sandown Park Station

Thursday 1 July to Tuesday 31 August 2021

Construction continues on the Cranbourne and Pakenham lines between Caulfield Station and Sandown Park Station, to install next-generation High Capacity Signalling trackside equipment and signalling technology as part of the Metro Tunnel.

Please read the information in this notification to familiarise yourself with the impacts of the works, including planned closures of the Cranbourne and Pakenham lines, car parking at Westall Station and on Newcomen Road in Springvale and sections of the shared user path.

What we are doing

- Trenching, boring and directional digging
- Installing pits and pipe
- Installing new trackside equipment
- Cable pulling and tray installation
- Lifting and installing steel framework on to the viaduct
- Soil sampling
- Non-destructive digging
- Removing trees and vegetation in the rail corridor
- Reinstating sections of the shared user path.

When

Day works:

Thursday 1 July to Tuesday 31 August 2021:

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays.

Night works (9pm to 4am):

- Monday 26 July to Thursday 29 July 2021

- Monday 16 August to Thursday 19 August 2021
- Monday 23 August to Thursday 26 August 2021.

What to be aware of

- Works will require the use of machinery including a non-destructive digging truck, excavator, dump truck, boring machine, hammer drill, concrete truck, light towers, generators, hand tools, cable winch, cable truck, hi-rail and light vehicles
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- Some sections of the Djerring Trail shared user path between Westall Station and Sandown Park Station will be temporarily closed in stages to enable trenching work to be completed. Closures will be clearly signed with traffic management and detours in place as required
- There will be intermittent closures of some car parking at Westall Station throughout July and August
- A number of car parking spaces along Newcomen Road (from Ericksen Street to Parsons Avenue) will be closed in stages until September 2021 to enable access to work zones. There will also be temporary lane closures along Newcomen Road at times
- The works will require removal of some trees in the rail corridor. The trees have been assessed by an arborist and designated as having low retention value



- Use of portable light towers will be required. Where possible they will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- For the safety of passengers and our workers, some of these activities can only be performed at night, when trains are not running.

Travel changes

Buses replace trains on the Cranbourne and Pakenham lines between Caulfield and Dandenong from approximately 9pm to last service each night, from:

- Monday 26 July to Thursday 29 July
- Monday 16 August to Thursday 19 August
- Monday 23 August to Thursday 26 August.

Buses also replace trains between Richmond Junction and Caulfield from approximately 9pm to last service each night, from Monday 30 August to Thursday 2 September

Passengers should allow extra travel time.
