Landscaping works

William Street pocket park, South Yarra

Saturday 26 June 2021

As part of the William Street pocket park landscaping works, a 6.5-metre palm tree will be delivered and planted.

What we are doing

- The tree will be transported on low-loader trucks and unloaded on site
- Works will involve an excavator, a crane to lift the tree into place and crews with hand tools.

When

- Saturday 26 June
- Between 7am to 1pm.

What you should be aware of

- Temporary access delays are expected between 10 and 8 William streets while the tree is unloaded into site. Traffic management will be in place to safely facilitate vehicle movement during this time
- Works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise.

Health and safety

Metro Tunnel works are progressing safely under the current circuit breaker coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions in Victoria.

Construction is an authorised industry and COVIDsafe Plans are in place on all our project sites. The health and safety of our workforce and community is our top priority.

Workers on all of Victoria's Big Build sites are currently required to wear face masks unless they meet any of the criteria for exception – such as a medical condition or to meet Occupational Health and Safety guidelines.

Physical distancing measures are in place, as well as increased hygiene practices.
